Answers in Red

1. Do stumps need to be ground level?
Yes, for safety all stumps need to be ground level.
2. Can we keep a portion of the trees or are they all to be stacked?
Yes, 25-30% of the trees can be retained by the selected bidder. This value should be reflected in your proposal.
3. Will the agreement allow a percentage down?
Yes, a material deposit can be negotiated.
4. Can Non-harvestable rotten trees can be mulched with the brush?
Yes, with approval, non-harvestable rotten trees can be mulched.
5. Is there a minimum sized log that is needed to be stacked?
With approval, small trees under 6-8" can be considered.
6. Is there a concern with disturbing vegetation in work areas?
No concern about disturbing the vegetation in the areas that is used for falling and processing trees. All though special care should be taken, avoiding major ruts with heavy equipment should be taken into consideration.
